Subject: General letter for lot numbering of Zeocin Selection Reagent (catalogue number R25001)

Dear Valued Customer,

This letter is to explain why lot numbers on zeocin vials are different than the lot numbers on the packaging of the overall kit (case holding the 8 vials).

The reason there is a separate lot number for the kit and component(s) inside the kit is for traceability purposes. Our ERP system automatically assigns a kit a part number (SKU) and lot number and each component (vial) within the kit a SKU and lot number. Expiration dates are assigned based on the lot number of the overall kit the components come in.
